Claremont Street

LOCATION: 595th St and 120th Ave, Claremont, MN 55924

TYPE: Historic, District

HISTORY: Alonzo Way first settled here in 1854 and named this village after Claremont, New Hampshire. C.O. Kidder also laid claim on Claremont Street and built a large two-story home which served as a stagecoach inn for several years. The Claremont Street post office was set up in the home of George Way. By 1860, the village consisted of a school, blacksmith shop, cheese factory, stores, cemetery, and a church. When the railroad went south of Claremont Street, the people moved businesses to the railroad, which became the village of Claremont that we know today.
