

ORDINANCE NO. 24-1114

**AN ORDINANCE CREATING SECTION 7.30 OF THE CLAREMONT CITY CODE
REGULATING FOOD TRUCKS**

The City Council of Claremont, Minnesota ordains:

1. **Claremont City Code Section 7.30, regulating Food Trucks, is hereby created by inserting the following:**

“SEC. 7.30. FOOD TRUCKS

Subd. 1. Definitions. The following terms, as used in this Section, shall have the meanings stated:

- A. “Food Truck” means a motor vehicle in which food of any kind are carried for the purposes of selling at retail sale out of the vehicle to the public.

Subd. 2. Operation. A Food Truck may conduct retail sales of food within the City only in accordance with the requirements set forth in this Section.

Subd. 3. License. A Food Truck conducting retail sales within the City must be licensed by the Minnesota Department of Health, as required by Minnesota law. Upon request, the owner or operator of the Food Truck shall provide the City with proof of proper licensure.

Subd. 4. Insurance. A Food Truck conducting retail sales within the City shall carry liability insurance insuring the owner against liability imposed by law arising out of ownership, maintenance or operation of such Food Truck in amounts of \$500,000 for injury or death of one person and \$1,500,000 for the injury or death of two or more persons and \$10,000 for damage to property. Upon request, the owner or operator of the Food Truck shall provide the City with proof of proper insurance.

Subd. 5. Restrictions on Retail Sales; Locations.

- A. An operator shall conduct retail sales only when the Food Truck is lawfully stopped.
- B. A Food Truck may only conduct retail sales at the following locations:
 1. Henning Park
 2. Harmer Park


When conducting retail sales at these locations, the Food Truck shall not be parked on a public road.

Subd. 6. City Authorization. Prior to conducting retail sales within the City, the owner/operator shall obtain written permission from the City as to the locations, dates, and times that retail sales may be conducted.

Subd. 7. Sound Amplification Devices. No operator of a Food Truck shall utilize a sound amplification device.”

2. This ordinance becomes effective upon passage and publication.
